or – gives a choice
one – the number 1

said – told something
there – a place
use – to take advantage of something

an – used before vowel sounds
each – every single one
which – asks about choices
she – a girl
do – an action
how – the way something happens
their – belongs to them and – adds information
if – shows a condition

A word that sounds like another word is called a **homophone** (*same sound, different spelling, different meaning.*)

Spelling Word → Sound-Alike(s) → Definitions

or → *ore* (rock with metal), *oar* (used to row a boat)
one → *won* (past tense of win)
by → *buy* (purchase), *bye* (good-bye)
but → *butt* (a push or blow) *also* (the part of the body you sit on)
not → *knot* (tied rope), *naught* (nothing)
we → *wee* (small)
your → *you're* (you are)
their → *there* (a place), *they're* (they are)
there → *their* (belongs to them), *they're* (they are)
which → *witch* (a person with magical powers)
were → *we're* (we are)
use → *yews* (type of tree), *ewes* (female sheep)
an → (sound-alike confusion with “a”)
